During the afternoon session of the meeting, the following common points of intersection and interest were recorded. (Note: Congressional and state agency staff acted as observers only.)

- ❖ Increase funding for conservation programs and maintain all conservation programs (WRP, CRP, CSP, EQIP, WHIP, etc).
- ❖ Increase technical assistance funding for conservation staff and equipment.
- ❖ Prioritize biomass energy demonstration and research targeting diverse sources and widely dispersed implementation and control.
- ❖ Maintain the safety net function of the commodity title to keep farms profitable and rural economies vital.
