During the afternoon session of the meeting, the following common points of intersection and interest were recorded. (Note: Congressional and state agency staff acted as observers only.)

- ❖ Prioritize increased and adequate funding for conservation technical assistance.
- ❖ Continue support and funding for conservation programs, including the Wetlands Reserve Program, Conservation Reserve Program, and other Title II programs.
- ❖ Maintain the safety net function of the commodity title to keep farms profitable and enduring.
- ❖ Support closing loopholes that allow recipients unlimited payments.
- ❖ Support the Sodsaver provision to achieve conservation and budget savings.
