Schedule

Thursday, July 15: Technology "Dry Run"

The convention will be conducted using Zoom. If you have not used Zoom or want to test your technology prior to the convention, national staff will host a training session on July 15 beginning at 7:30 p.m. Eastern / 6:30 p.m. Central time. Staff will demonstrate basic functions and conduct a few mock votes to help chapter delegates and National Directors familiarize themselves with the voting process that will be used during the convention.

To join the training session, register for convention and simply use that same link the evening of July 15.

Tuesday, July 20 afternoon: Retired U.S. Senator David Durenberger of Minnesota will deliver the opening keynote address about the vital role that community-based organizations, like the League, can play in addressing our most pressing conservation challenges. Following a Q&A session with our guest speaker, we will hold National Officer elections. The general session will wrap up with the Board of Directors meeting, at which the Executive Board elections will be conducted.

7 p.m.: Virtual Parade of States

Wednesday, July 21 afternoon: On the second day of Convention, we'll kick off our 100th anniversary fundraising campaign! And you won't want to miss the premiere of our new video introducing the centennial Convention in East Peoria, Illinois.
